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HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO CREATE A PLAN TO ADDRESS OVERCROWDING IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN KAPOLEI, EWA, AND WAIPAHU.

WHEREAS, Kapolei, Ewa, and Waipahu are some of the fastest-growing communities on Oahu and in the state as a whole; and

WHEREAS, large numbers of young families with school-aged children are moving to Kapolei, Ewa, and Waipahu because of the relatively more-affordable housing in these areas; and

WHEREAS, student enrollment is projected to increase at public schools in Kapolei, Ewa, and Waipahu; and

WHEREAS, when overcrowding at public schools occurs, it adversely affects both teaching conditions for teachers and learning conditions for students; and

WHEREAS, because of overcrowding, there are reports of public school teachers who must teach classes that are startlingly large in size; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature appropriated \$10,000,000 as a lump sum to the Department of Education to address overcrowding in public schools; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-eighth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016, that the Department of Education is requested to establish a task force to address overcrowding in public schools in Kapolei, Ewa, and Waipahu; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following individuals are requested to serve as members of the task force:
