A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LA'I'ŌPUA COMMUNITY CENTER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$3,346,868 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
5 for the purpose of providing the necessary funding for the
6 completion of the La'i'Ōpua community center to support a variety
7 of social, educational, and cultural programs and services for
8 the Kealakehe communities and surrounding neighborhoods.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
10 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sum appropriated shall be expended by the
15 department of Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.





