A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HALEAKALĀ NATIONAL PARK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3 designated and to read as follows:

4 "§286- Special license plates for Haleakala National
5 Park authorized. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
6 any owner of a passenger motor vehicle, who is a resident of the
7 State, upon application, may be issued a Haleakala National Park
8 special license plate for the owner's passenger vehicle to
9 observe the importance of the Haleakala National Park in Hawaii.

10 (b) The Haleakala National Park special license plate
11 shall:

12 (1) Contain words or an image that indicates the plates
13 are issued to recognize the Haleakala National Park;

14 (2) Be similar in shape, size, and color to the regulation
15 passenger motor vehicle number plate prescribed by
16 law; and



1 (3) Be securely fastened to the passenger motor vehicle in
2 lieu of the regulation number plate.

3 (c) In addition to any other fee authorized by law, for
4 each Haleakala National Park special license plate issued, the
5 applicant shall pay the cost of the plates plus administrative
6 costs of furnishing the Haleakala National Park special license
7 plate."

8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
