A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO POLICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 52D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 " [\$52D-1] Police commission. A police commission is
4 created for each of the counties. The composition, appointment,
5 terms of office, staff, powers, duties, and functions of each
6 police commission shall be prescribed by the charter of each
7 county[-]; provided that the duties shall include the
8 establishment of procedures regarding the suspension, removal
9 from a specified duty for disciplinary reasons, or termination
10 of any police officer."

11 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13 begun before its effective date.

14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
