# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$59,770,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016  
5 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
6 the seventeenth senatorial district, as follows:

7    1.    Waipahu high school

8           A.    Design, planning, and construction of  
9                school-wide electrical upgrade; ground  
10               and site improvements; equipment and  
11               appurtenances.

15           B.    Design, construction, and equipment for  
16                a new elevated classroom building with

18           SECTION 2.   The appropriation made for the capital  
 19   improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
 20   the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;



1 provided that all moneys from the appropriation that are  
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
4 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
5 expended by the department of education for the purposes of this  
6 Act.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
