A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING A CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT RELATING TO THE
CONSERVATION, CONTROL AND DEVELOPMENT OF RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2 amendment to article XI of the Constitution of the State of
3 Hawaii to promote the conservation and protection of Hawaii's
4 game resources.

5 SECTION 2. Article XI of the Constitution of the State of
6 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
7 designated and to read as follows:

8 "GAME RESOURCES

9 Section . The State shall manage for the perpetuity of
10 future generations, game animals, including goats, sheep, deer
11 and pigs presently located throughout all state lands. The
12 management of game animals shall be subject to guidelines
13 established by the legislature, including cooperative resource
14 management strategies which shall ensure the public's sustained
15 use and enjoyment of game animals as a protected state
16 resource."

1 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
2 be as follows:


3 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Hawaii be amended to
4 recognize game animals located throughout all state lands as
5 a protected state resource to be managed pursuant to
6 guidelines established by the legislature for the public's
7 sustained use and enjoyment?"

8 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

9 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
10 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
11 the State of Hawaii.
