# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER RECLAMATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. (a) The corrections division of the department  
2 of public safety shall conduct a feasibility study on the use of  
3 water scalping technology in Halawa correctional facility and,  
4 if funds are available, may develop a process design for the  
5 processing portion of the implementation of water scalping  
6 technology.

7           (b) The feasibility study shall include an analysis of the  
8 following:

9           (1) Potential benefit to the State from the development of  
10 water scalping technology;

11           (2) Compatibility of water scalping technology with the  
12 existing Halawa correctional facility infrastructure;

13           (3) Cost projections to:

14           (A) Upgrade the existing Halawa correctional facility  
15 to incorporate water scalping technology; and



1 (B) Incorporate water scalping technology in any  
2 construction plans for new state buildings near  
3 Halawa correctional facility; and

4 (4) Potential incentives for private industry to utilize  
5 water scalping technology in a way that benefits the  
6 State.

7 (c) The corrections division of the department of public  
8 safety shall submit to the legislature, no later than twenty  
9 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2017, a  
10 report on its findings and recommendations. The report shall  
11 include recommendations on:

12 (1) Specific areas within or near Halawa correctional  
13 facility where water scalping technology should be  
14 deployed; and

15 (2) If practicable, process design for the processing  
16 portion of the implementation of water scalping  
17 technology.

18 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much  
20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for the  
21 corrections division of the department of public safety to



1 conduct a feasibility study on the use of water scalping  
2 technology in Halawa correctional facility and, if funds are  
3 available, develop a process design for the processing portion  
4 of the implementation of water scalping technology.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
