
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2016.

3 SECTION 2. Act 138, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015, is
4 amended by amending part II to read as follows:

5 **"PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS**

6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
10 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. The total
11 expenditures and the number of permanent positions established
12 in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the
13 sums and the position ceilings indicated for each year, except
14 as provided in this Act.

1 SECTION 4. Part III, Act 138, Session Laws of Hawaii 2015,
2 is amended as follows:

3 (1) By amending section 7 to read as follows:

4 "SECTION 7. Provided that of the general funds
5 appropriated for administration (JUD601), the sum of \$600,000 or
6 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2015-2016
7 ~~[and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for~~
8 ~~fiscal year 2016-2017]~~ shall be expended for purchase of service
9 contracts for civil legal services; provided further that the
10 administrative director of the courts shall submit to the
11 legislature by February 1, 2016 a report listing the purchase of
12 service contracts entered into from July 1, 2015, to December
13 31, 2015, the purpose of the contracts, and contract award
14 amounts; and provided further that the administrative director
15 of the courts at least twenty days prior to the convening of the
16 regular sessions of 2016 and 2017, shall submit to the
17 legislature a report listing: the purchase of service contracts
18 entered into in the immediately preceding fiscal year; the
19 purpose of the contracts; the contract award amounts;
20 expenditures and encumbrances under the contracts; and program
21 measures achieved by the contractors."

22 (2) By adding a new section to read as follows:



1 "SECTION 7.1. Provided that of the general fund
2 appropriation for judiciary administration (JUD 601), the sum of
3 \$1,550,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
4 year 2016-2017 shall be expended as grants pursuant to chapter
5 42F, Hawaii revised statutes as follows:

6 (1) Not more than \$465,000 for Domestic Violence
7 Action Center;

8 (2) Not more than \$930,000 for Legal Aid Society of
9 Hawaii; and

10 (3) Not more than \$155,000 for Volunteer Legal
11 Services Hawaii."

12 SECTION 5. If any portion of this Act or its application
13 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
14 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
15 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
16 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
17 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
18 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
19 extent possible.

20 SECTION 6. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
21 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice
22 may correct the error. All changes made pursuant to this



1 section shall be reported to the legislature at its next regular
2 session.

3 SECTION 7. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

5 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
