A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVER LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that section 249-9.2,
2 Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to special number plates for
3 military service, allows veterans of the Korean conflict to have
4 "Korea Veteran" imprinted on their Hawaii license plates.

5 The purpose of this Act is to clarify that the definition
6 of "veteran" for purposes of notation on a driver's license
7 includes veterans of the Korean conflict.

8 SECTION 2. Section 286-109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

10 "(a) Upon payment of the required fee and upon
11 demonstrating the ability to operate a certain category or
12 categories of motor vehicles to the satisfaction of the examiner
13 of drivers, an applicant for a driver's license shall be issued
14 a single license of a design approved by the director of
15 transportation upon which is made a notation of:

16 (1) The category or categories of motor vehicles the
17 applicant may operate;



- 1 (2) Any restrictive provisions to which the license is
2 subject;
- 3 (3) Veteran status, if desired by the applicant; provided
4 that the notation shall be on the front of the license
5 and shall not include any designation other than the
6 term "veteran"; and
- 7 (4) When the license is issued to a person under twenty-
8 one years of age, a statement, in clearly legible
9 print that shall contrast with the other information
10 appearing on the license, which indicates the date on
11 which the person will attain the age of twenty-one
12 years.

13 As used in this subsection, "veteran" means any person who
14 served in any of the uniformed services of the United States,
15 including veterans of the Korean conflict, and was discharged
16 under conditions other than dishonorable."

17 SECTION 3. Section 286-111, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

19 "(d) Every application shall state the full name, date of
20 birth, sex, occupation, veteran status if applicable (including
21 veterans of the Korean conflict) and desired by the applicant,





1 social security number if the applicant is eligible for a social
2 security number, the residence address, and business address, if
3 any, of the applicant, shall briefly describe the applicant, and
4 shall state whether the applicant has theretofore been licensed
5 as a driver, and, if so, when and in what state or country, and
6 whether any such license has ever been suspended or revoked, or
7 whether an application has ever been refused, and if so, the
8 date of and reason for the suspension, revocation, or refusal."

9 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
