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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NOTARY PUBLIC FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 456-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "~~§456-17~~ Fees. Subject to section 456-18, every notary  
4 public is entitled to demand and receive the following fees:

5 For noting the protest of mercantile paper, [~~\$5~~] \$10;

6 For each notice and certified copy of protest, [~~\$5~~] \$10;

7 For noting any other protest, [~~\$5~~] \$10;

8 For every notice thereof, and certified copy of protest,

9 [~~\$5~~] \$10;

10 For every deposition, or official certificate, [~~\$5~~] \$25;

11 For the administration of oath, including the certificate  
12 of the oath, [~~\$5~~] \$25; for affixing the certificate of the oath  
13 to every duplicate original instrument beyond four, [~~\$2-50~~] \$5;

14 For taking any acknowledgment, [~~\$5~~] \$25 for each party  
15 signing; for affixing to every duplicate original beyond one of  
16 any instrument acknowledged before the notary, the notary's  
17 certificate of the acknowledgment, [~~\$2-50~~] \$5 for each person  
18 making the acknowledgment."



1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
3 begun before its effective date.

4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2017.
