A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL MARIJUANA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 329D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
3	and to read as follows:
4	"Enclosed indoor facility" means a permanent, stationary
5	structure with a:
6	(1) Solid floor; and
7	(2) Rigid exterior including:
8	(A) Walls that encircle the structure on all sides;
9	and
10	(B) A roof attached to the walls;
11	that prevent the interior from being seen from outside
12	the structure,
13	provided that an enclosed indoor facility excludes a greenhouse
14	or shade house that does not comply with these requirements."
15	SECTION 2. Section 329D-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended by adding three new definitions to be appropriately
17	inserted and to read as follows:

1	"Enclosed indoor facility" means a permanent, stationary
2	structure with a:
3	(1) Solid floor; and
4	(2) Rigid exterior including:
5	(A) Walls that encircle the structure on all sides;
6	and
7	(B) A roof attached to the walls;
8	that prevent the interior from being seen from outside
9	the structure.
10	"Greenhouse" means a permanent, stationary structure having
11	walls and a roof that are transparent or translucent, for the
12	cultivation of plants within the structure under controlled
13	conditions.
14	"Shade house" means a temporary or permanent structure that
15	includes a rigid frame over which cloth, lattice, or screen is
16	placed to create shade for the cultivation of plants within the
17	structure."
18	SECTION 3. Section 329D-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
19	amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
20	"(f) All dispensary facilities, including but not limited
21	to production centers and retail dispensing locations, [shall be

- 1 enclosed indoor facilities and shall maintain twenty-four hour
- 2 security measures, including but not limited to an alarm system,
- 3 video monitoring and recording on the premises, and exterior
- 4 lighting. Production centers licensed on or after October 1,
- 5 2017, may include greenhouses or shade houses; provided that all
- 6 production center facilities shall [remain locked at all times.]
- 7 be secured at all times. Retail dispensing locations shall be
- 8 enclosed indoor facilities and remain locked at all times, other
- 9 than business hours as authorized by subsection (e), and shall
- 10 only be opened for authorized persons."
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall not affect the medical marijuana
- 12 dispensary selection process to be completed and announced by
- 13 April 15, 2016, pursuant to section 329D-5(b), Hawaii Revised
- 14 Statutes.
- 15 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112;
- 18 provided that section 1 shall be repealed on September 30, 2017;
- 19 provided further that sections 2 and 3 shall take effect on
- 20 October 1, 2017.

Repeals the requirement that medical marijuana dispensary facilities, except retail dispensing locations, be enclosed indoor facilities, and allows medical marijuana production centers licensed after 10/1/2017, to include secured greenhouses or shade houses. Effective 7/1/2112. (HD1)
