# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOCIAL WORKERS.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that social workers in
2	Hawaii who are working to complete their licensed clinical
3	social worker requirements must complete three thousand hours of
4	supervised work experience, one hundred hours of which must be
5	by direct face-to-face supervision. The legislature further
6	finds that certain social workers, particularly those living on
7	the less populated islands, in rural areas, and those employed
8	by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs, may
9	experience difficulty meeting the direct face-to-face
10	supervision requirement. This is especially true for social
11	workers in rural areas, as there are a limited number of rural
12	social workers who are qualified to provide supervision for
13	applicants for licensure as clinical social workers.
14	The legislature additionally finds that telehealth has
15	become standard practice in social work and the mental health
16	field and should be permitted as a means of meeting the

- 2 social worker.
- 3 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify the
- 4 supervision requirements for licensure of clinical social
- 5 workers, including by permitting the option to fulfill all or
- 6 part of the face-to-face supervision requirements through
- 7 supervision via a video conference service that is compliant
- 8 with all federal and state privacy, security, and
- 9 confidentiality laws, including the Health Insurance Portability
- 10 and Accountability Act of 1996.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 467E-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 "§467E-7 Licensing requirements. Every applicant for a
- 14 license as a social worker shall submit evidence satisfactory to
- 15 the director that the applicant meets the following
- 16 requirements:
- 17 (1) For the licensed bachelor social worker, the
- 18 applicant:
- 19 (A) Holds a bachelor's degree from a college or
- 20 university in a social work program accredited by
- or deemed to be equivalent to a program

1		accredited by the Council on Social Work
2		Education; and
3		(B) Has passed the basic level national examination
4		given by the Association of Social Work Boards;
5	(2)	For the licensed social worker, the applicant:
6		(A) Holds a master's degree from a college or
7		university in a social work program accredited by
8		or deemed to be equivalent to an accredited
9		program by the Council on Social Work Education
10		or a doctoral degree from a doctoral degree
11		program in social work accredited by the Western
12		Association of Schools and Colleges or a
13		comparable regional accreditation body; and
14		(B) Has passed the intermediate or higher level
15		national examination given by the Association of
16		Social Work Boards; and
17	(3)	For the licensed clinical social worker, the
18		applicant:
19		(A) Has met the educational requirements in paragraph
20		(2);

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2		examination given by the Association of Social
3		Work Boards; and
4	(C)	Has provided evidence of successful completion of
5		at least three thousand hours of post masters
6		clinical social work experience under supervision
7		completed within no fewer than two years, but
8		within no more than five years. Clinical social
9		work experience shall include a minimum of two
10		thousand hours of assessment, clinical diagnosis,
11		and psychotherapy; no more than a maximum of nine
12		hundred hours of client-centered advocacy,
13		consultation, and evaluation; and at least one
14		hundred hours of direct face-to-face
15		supervision[+] as follows:
16		(i) At least sixty of the one hundred hours of

1	<u>(E)</u>	In collaboration with the supervisor, may elect
2		to fulfill some or all of the supervision
3		requirements set forth in subparagraph (C)
4		through face-to-face supervision that is
5		conducted electronically through a video
6		conference service that is compliant with all
7		federal and state privacy, security, and
8		confidentiality laws, including the Health
9		Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of
10		1996. Prior to making such an election, it is
11		incumbent upon the applicant to review the laws
12		and rules of other jurisdictions to determine the
13		impact, if any, that electronic supervision may
14		have on license by endorsement in other states."
15	SECTION 3	. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken.	New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 4	. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
