A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,793,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the tenth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Kuhio elementary school

8 Construction of two hundred
9 linear-foot wall; installation of
10 new fence on top of the wall.

13 Construction of 1,550 square foot
14 concrete sidewalk from D building
15 to back driveway.

18 Design and construction of play
19 area, including resurfacing of
20 basketball court and addition of a



1 covered shelter for part of the
2 play area.

3 Total funding \$1,500,000

4 6. Jefferson elementary school

5 Plans, design, and construction of
6 Waikiki Cultural Museum on school
7 grounds

8 Total funding \$550,000

9 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
10 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
11 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
15 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the
16 department of education for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
