# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§201-     State program for economic development. (a) The  
5 department shall create a state program for economic  
6 development.

7           (b) The purpose of the program shall be to promote  
8 economic development in the fields of clean energy, high  
9 technology, and healthcare. The program shall:

10           (1) Make policy recommendations to the legislature  
11           regarding tax credits and other incentives to increase  
12           job creation and job training in the fields of clean  
13           energy, high technology, and healthcare;

14           (2) Create a separate ten-year plan to increase job  
15           creation and job training in the fields of clean  
16           energy, high technology, and healthcare;

17           (3) Annually update the ten-year plan; and

1        (4) Submit an annual report to the legislature detailing  
 2        any accomplishments of the program during the last  
 3        calendar year, the formulation and progress of the  
 4        current ten-year plan, and any further findings and  
 5        recommendations."

6        SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

7        SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
