A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the population of
2 the area of Kakaako in the city and county of Honolulu has
3 recently undergone a dramatic increase in population. There has
4 been the development of numerous residential condominiums and an
5 increase in businesses serving the residents. Correspondingly,
6 there has been a steady and marked increase of calls for
7 emergency medical services in the Kakaako area.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
9 department of health for the purchase of an ambulance vehicle
10 and the operational costs for one ambulance unit, including
11 equipment, supplies, and personnel costs for state-certified
12 emergency medical service personnel.

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,992,888.08 or so
15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for
16 the purchase of an ambulance vehicle and the operational costs
17 for one ambulance unit, including equipment, supplies, and







1 personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical service
2 personnel, to service the area of Kakaako in the city and county
3 of Honolulu.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
5 health for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
