A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO FUND BEFORE-, AFTER- AND INTERSESSION-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2 amendment to article X of the Constitution of the State of
3 Hawaii to require the legislature to annually appropriate moneys
4 to support K-12 before-, after-, and intersession-school care
5 programs.

6 SECTION 2. Article X of the Constitution of the State of
7 Hawaii is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately
8 designated and to read as follows:

9 "BEFORE-, AFTER- AND INTERSESSION-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAMS"

10 Section . The legislature shall annually appropriate
11 moneys out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii for
12 the purpose of supporting before-, after- and intersession-
13 school care programs serving grades kindergarten through
14 twelve."

15 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
16 be as follows:


1 "Shall the State be required to annually provide general
2 funds to support K-12 before-, after- and intersession-
3 school care programs?"

4 SECTION 4. New constitutional material is underscored.

5 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
6 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
7 the State of Hawaii.
