A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$70,250,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the second
6 senatorial district, as follows:

1 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
2 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the capital
7 improvement projects set forth in section 1 of this Act shall be
8 expended by the following expending agencies for the purposes of
9 this Act:

- 10 (1) For item 1, the department of land and natural
11 resources;
- 12 (2) For item 2, the department of education;
- 13 (3) For item 3, the department of health; and
- 14 (4) For items 4 to 6, the department of transportation.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
