## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 88, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to subpart C of part II to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§88- Retirement benefit incentives for members
5	separated from service. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to
6	the contrary, an active member is eligible for a temporary
7	retirement benefit incentive if:
8	(1) The member serves in a position that has been
9	identified for layoff due to the consolidation or
10	abolition of functions, or the privatization of the
11	functions of the position; and
12	(2) The member is otherwise eligible for a service
13	retirement as of the date of application for
14	retirement.
15	(b) An active member who is eligible under subsection (a)
16	for a retirement benefit incentive shall receive a retirement
17	incentive of one year of additional retirement credit

- 1 for each year of service credit earned as of the date of
- 2 retirement or separation from service pursuant to subsection
- 3 (a) (1), up to a maximum of years of service credit as of
- 4 the date of retirement."
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 to pay for
- 8 the retirement benefit incentive for members separated from
- 9 service pursuant to this Act.
- 10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 11 budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059,
- 14 and shall be repealed on July 1, 2091.
