A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE THIRTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$8,841,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2016-2017
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 thirteenth senatorial district, as follows:
- 7 1. Central middle school
 - 8 A. Design and construct
9 an aquaponics/hydroponics
10 system. \$200,000
 - 11 B. Renovate A building
12 restrooms. \$200,000
 - 13 C. Renovate C building
14 restrooms. \$200,000
 - 15 D. Renovate D building
16 restrooms. \$150,000

4 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 5 improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 6 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
 7 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
 8 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

9 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the capital projects
 10 set forth in section 1 shall be expended as follows for the
 11 purposes of this Act:

- 12 (1) For items 1, 2, 3, and 4, by the department of
 13 education;
- 14 (2) For item 5, the sum shall be appropriated as a grant
 15 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
 16 Kuakini Health System, to be expended by the
 17 department of health;
- 18 (3) For item 6, by the department of health;
- 19 (4) For item 7, the sum shall be appropriated as a grant
 20 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
 21 the Chinese Chamber of Commerce, to be expended by the

2 tourism;

3 (5) For item 8, the sum shall be appropriated as a grant
4 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
5 the Hawaii Theatre Center, to be expended by the
6 department of accounting and general services; and

7 (6) For item 9, the sum shall be appropriated as a grant
8 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to
9 Docomomo US, to be expended by the department of land
10 and natural resources.

11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
