
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic
2 development, and tourism shall conduct a study on the
3 feasibility of establishing a public-private partnership
4 resource agency within the department of business, economic
5 development, and tourism, for all state departments, divisions,
6 and agencies to utilize.
- 7 (b) The services of the resource agency shall include the
8 following:
- 9 (1) Providing advice, expertise, guidance, and information
10 to all state departments, divisions, and agencies
11 concerning the formation of public-private
12 partnerships between state government and the private
13 sector;
- 14 (2) Assisting in the formation of a public-private
15 partnership for any particular project or undertaking;



1 (3) Serving as one of the state's representatives in
2 negotiating a contract for a public-private
3 partnership; and

4 (4) Doing all things necessary in furtherance of this
5 subsection.

6 (c) The department of business, economic development, and
7 tourism shall report its findings and recommendations, including
8 any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than
9 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
10 2017.

11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2016-2017 for a
14 study on the feasibility of establishing a public-private
15 partnership resource agency within the department of business,
16 economic development, and tourism.

17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
18 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
19 this Act.

20 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
