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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
EIGHTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act, are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2016-2017:

5           1. To be expended by the department of education:

6           A. Hanalei elementary school, Kauai

7           Plans, design, construction, and equipment for  
8           technical infrastructure upgrades; installation of  
9           CAT6 copper cables; replacement of fiber backbone  
10          between buildings; and installation of new IDF's, as
