A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFLICTS OF INTEREST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 84-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) No employee shall take any official action directly
4 affecting:

5 (1) A business or other undertaking in which the employee
6 has a substantial financial interest; [~~or~~]

7 (2) A private undertaking in which the employee is engaged
8 as legal counsel, advisor, consultant, representative,
9 or other agency capacity[~~-~~]; or

10 (3) A business or other undertaking in which the employee
11 knows or has reason to know that a parent, sibling, or
12 emancipated child of the employee has a substantial
13 financial interest.

14 A department head who is unable to disqualify the
15 department head's self on any matter described in paragraphs (1)
16 [~~and~~], (2), and (3) will not be in violation of this subsection



1 if the department head has complied with the disclosure
2 requirements of section 84-17.

3 A person whose position on a board, commission, or
4 committee is mandated by statute, resolution, or executive order
5 to have particular qualifications shall only be prohibited from
6 taking official action that directly and specifically affects a
7 business or undertaking in which the person has a substantial
8 financial interest; provided that the substantial financial
9 interest is related to the member's particular qualifications."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
