A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FOURTEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$15,142,500 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fourteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Dole middle school

8 A. Update technology infrastructure.

9 Labor \$76,621

10 Construction \$139,087

11 Equipment \$20,792

12 Total funding \$236,500

13 2. Mayor Joseph Fern elementary school

14 A. Construct covered walkway between
15 buildings B and I to the library

7 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
 8 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 9 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
 10 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
 11 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.

12 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
 13 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
 14 expended by the appropriate expending agency for the purposes of
 15 this Act.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
