# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately  
3 designated and to read as follows:

4           "§103D-       Single-serving bottled water; prohibition on  
5 using state funds to purchase. (a) Notwithstanding sections  
6 103D-102(b)(3), (b)(4)(H), and (b)(4)(L) and 103D-305, no state  
7 agency shall use state funds for the purchase of single-serving  
8 bottled water, except as provided in subsection (b).

9           (b) The following circumstances shall constitute  
10 exceptions to subsection (a):

11           (1) Public health and safety preparedness, emergencies,  
12 investigations, and extended deployments or  
13 activations of the office of hazard evaluation and  
14 emergency response of the department of health or the  
15 department of defense;

16           (2) Situations where there is high risk of cross-  
17 contamination with non-potable or contaminated water;  
18           or



1           (3) Situations where there are no reasonable alternatives  
2           to bottled water, such as large public events and when  
3           large quantities of water may need to be distributed  
4           for health and safety reasons.

5           (c) For purposes of this section:

6           "State agency" means a department, division, agency,  
7           office, board, commission, bureau, or council of the State.

8           "State funds" means any money deposited into or drawn from  
9           the state treasury or any special or trust fund of the State.

10          "State funds" includes any money appropriated by the State and  
11          transferred to any state agency that is used by the state  
12          agency, in whole or in part, to purchase goods or services."

13          SECTION 2.   New statutory material is underscored.

14          SECTION 3.   This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
