A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established within the department the
4	teacher national board certification incentive program to
5	recognize and support exemplary teaching practice by supporting
6	public school teachers who have achieved national board
7	certification under the certification program of the National
8	Board for Professional Teaching Standards. The teacher national
9	board certification incentive program shall provide:
10	(1) A \$5,000 bonus per year for each public school teacher
11	who maintains current national board certification;
12	(2) \$1,500 upon completing all components of the
13	certification program of the National Board for
14	Professional Teaching Standards;
15	(3) A reimbursement of the remainder of the national board
16	certification application fee upon achievement of
17	national board certification; [and]

•	(4) All	addictional \$5,000 bonds per year for each public

3	cei	rtification and who teaches at:
4	(A)	[A-school-that is in restructuring under the No

16	<u>(5)</u> An	additional \$5,000 bonus per year for any public
17	sch	nool teacher who received a yearly bonus pursuant to
18	par	ragraph (4); provided that the teacher maintains
19	nat	tional board certification and continues teaching in
20	the	same school after the school transitions out of
21	the	e qualifying designation pursuant to paragraph (4).

1	The teacher shall receive the additional bonus from		
2	the time the school no longer meets any of the		
3	criteria of paragraph (4) until the end date of the		
4	teacher's ten-year national board certification in		
5	effect at the time the school lost its designation, or		
6	until the teacher is no longer employed at the school,		
7	whichever occurs first."		
8	SECTION 2. This Act shall be applied retroactively to		
9	bonuses for the 2014 calendar year; provided that payment of		
10	such 2014 bonuses shall be made during the 2015 calendar year,		
11	in addition to any other bonuses for which the teacher is		
12	eligible for the 2015 calendar year.		
13	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
14	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
15	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
