
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ETHICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The disclosure of financial interest required by this
4 section shall be filed:
- 5 (1) By any person enumerated in subsection (c), except a
6 member of the legislature, between January 1 and
7 May 31 of each year;
- 8 (2) By a member of the legislature between January 1 and
9 January [~~31~~] 15 of each year;
- 10 (3) Within thirty days of a person's election or
11 appointment to a state position enumerated in
12 subsection (c); or
- 13 (4) Within thirty days of separation from a state position
14 if a prior financial disclosure statement for the
15 position was not filed within the one hundred eighty
16 days preceding the date of separation;
- 17 provided that candidates for state elective offices or the
18 constitutional convention shall file the required statements no



1 later than twenty days prior to the date of the primary election
2 for state offices or the election of delegates to the
3 constitutional convention."

4 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 7, 2059,
7 and shall apply to calendar years commencing with the year 2016.
