# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTIETH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$221,850,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2015-2016  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the  
6 twentieth senatorial district, as follows:

16 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
18 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are  
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2018, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
3 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

4 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 8 shall be  
5 expended by the department of education;

6 (2) The sum appropriated in item 9 shall be expended by  
7 the Hawaii community development authority;


8 (3) The sum appropriated in item 10 shall be expended by  
9 the University of Hawaii; and

10 (4) The sums appropriated in items 11 and 12 shall be  
11 expended by the department of transportation.

12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
