## SENATE RESOLUTION

---

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENTS OF HEALTH AND EDUCATION TO  
COLLABORATE ON EDUCATIONAL INFORMATION AND MATERIALS ABOUT  
THE HUMAN PAPILLOMAVIRUS VACCINE THAT CAN BE PROVIDED TO  
PARENTS OF PUBLIC MIDDLE AND INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL CHILDREN.

1           WHEREAS, according to the federal Centers for Disease  
2 Control and Prevention, human papillomavirus is a very common  
3 virus, with about 79,000,000 Americans currently infected and  
4 about 14,000,000 people newly infected each year; and  
5

6           WHEREAS, human papillomavirus can cause cervical, vaginal,  
7 and vulvar cancers in women; penile cancer in men; and anal  
8 cancer, cancer of the throat, and genital warts in men and  
9 women; and  
10

11           WHEREAS, the human papillomavirus vaccine is an important  
12 vaccine that can protect against infection and the cancers  
13 caused by human papillomavirus; and  
14

15           WHEREAS, the federal Centers for Disease Control and  
16 Prevention recommends the human papillomavirus vaccine for  
17 preteen boys and girls at age eleven or twelve, so they are  
18 protected prior to being exposed to the virus; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, the human papillomavirus vaccine also produces a  
21 more robust immune response during the preteen years, which  
22 could mean better protection for preteens who receive this  
23 vaccine; and  
24

25           WHEREAS, according to the federal Centers for Disease  
26 Control and Prevention, vaccination rates in Hawaii to protect  
27 against human papillomavirus are relatively low, with only  
28 thirty-four percent of women and fifteen percent of men in the  
29 State being fully immunized; and

31           WHEREAS, there is a need to increase public awareness about  
32 the human papillomavirus vaccine among parents and children;

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth  
 2 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016,  
 3 that the Departments of Health and Education are requested to  
 4 collaborate on educational information and materials about the  
 5 human papillomavirus vaccine that can be provided to parents of  
 6 public school children; and

 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is  
 9 requested to develop the information on human papillomavirus and  
 10 produce educational information and materials for distribution,  
 11 based on recommendations of the Advisory Committee on  
 12 Immunization Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and  
 13 Prevention; and

 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the educational information and  
 16 materials produced by the Department of Health are requested to  
 17 be disseminated by the Department of Education during student  
 18 orientation to parents of children who are attending public  
 19 middle schools and public intermediate schools in Hawaii; and

 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this  
 22 Resolution be transmitted to Director of Health and Chairperson  
 23 of the Board of Education.
