SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO RENAME A SECTION OF KAPULE HIGHWAY IN
THE COUNTY OF KAUA'I AS THE KAUA'I VETERANS MEMORIAL
HIGHWAY.

1 WHEREAS, military veterans have protected and sustained
2 liberty, freedom, and the American way of life for every citizen
3 of this country since the founding of the United States of
4 America; and

6 WHEREAS, the dedication and sacrifice of the men and women
7 of the United States Armed Forces who have courageously served
8 this country must be honored and not forgotten; and

10 WHEREAS, the sacrifices of those members of the United
11 States Armed Forces who have fallen, been wounded, or are
12 unaccounted for in conflicts with those who would infringe on
13 this country's freedoms and liberties, must be honored and not
14 forgotten; and

16 WHEREAS, it is imperative that the State of Hawaii
17 recognize and honor all veterans of the United States Armed
18 Forces in a tangible, permanent manner that is a constant
19 reminder of their sacrifice, dedication, and service; now,
20 therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth
23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016,
24 that the Governor is requested to take all necessary action to
25 rename and designate the section of Kapule Highway from Rice
26 Street to Ahukini Road in the County of Kaua'i as the Kaua'i
27 Veterans Memorial Highway; and

29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of
30 Transportation is requested to erect and maintain the
31 appropriate signage for the Kaua'i Veterans Memorial Highway; and





4 for Kapule Highway; and
