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## SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF ELECTIONS TO PROVIDE A STATUS UPDATE ON  
THE IMPLEMENTATION OF HAWAII'S NEW VOTER REGISTRATION  
SYSTEM.

1 WHEREAS, the Help America Vote Act of 2002 (HAVA) was  
2 signed into law on October 29, 2002, to establish a program to  
3 assist in the administration of elections; and  
4

5 WHEREAS, HAVA appropriated \$3,280,000,000 to the states, of  
6 which Hawaii received \$16,596,803; and  
7

8 WHEREAS, HAVA required states to comply with HAVA by  
9 January 1, 2006, and to use the funds to establish and implement  
10 new programs and standards pertaining to a computerized  
11 statewide voter registration database, provisional voting,  
12 voting information, updated and upgraded voting equipment,  
13 administrative complaints, and voter identification; and  
14

15 WHEREAS, HAVA does not require states to re-appropriate the  
16 funds, but instead requires that each state submit a state plan  
17 regarding programs and funds for publication in the Federal  
18 Register to the Election Assistance Commission; and  
19

20 WHEREAS, Hawaii's HAVA state plan was published in the  
21 Federal Register on March 24, 2004; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, computerized voter registration systems play a  
24 vital role in ensuring the accuracy and validity of the  
25 electoral process; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, Hawaii allocated \$4,000,000 of HAVA, section 251  
28 funds for a new voter registration system; and  
29

30 WHEREAS, the Office of Elections issued a request for  
31 proposals and executed a contract with a vendor to provide a new  
32 voter registration and election management system; and  
33

34 WHEREAS, as an election stakeholder, the Legislature needs  
35 assurance that the new voter registration system project is



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1 being properly managed and will be ready for use in the 2018  
2 elections; now, therefore,

3  
4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-eighth  
5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2016,  
6 that the Office of Elections is requested to provide the  
7 Legislature with a status update on the implementation of  
8 Hawaii's new voter registration system; and

9  
10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Elections is  
11 requested to include, at a minimum, the following information in  
12 the status update:

- 14 (1) Project management schedule that itemizes the various  
15 project deliverables and delivery timeline;
  - 16  
17 (2) Identification of completed deliverables and the  
18 amounts paid to the State's contractor;
  - 19  
20 (3) Description of the process used for quality assurance  
21 and resolution of issues or problems identified by  
22 users;
  - 23  
24 (4) Management plan for the voter registration system that  
25 includes descriptions of the projected annual  
26 operational costs, risk mitigation, and user support;  
27 and
  - 28  
29 (5) Itemization of expenditures from HAVA, sections 101  
30 and 251 funds; and

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Elections is  
33 requested to submit the status update to the Legislature no  
34 later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular  
35 Session of 2017; and

2 Resolution be transmitted to the Chief Election Officer.
