Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1063  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to assist the City and County  
of Honolulu Emergency Medical Services Division with expanding  
emergency medical services and ambulance services in the Moanalua,  
Aliamanu, Salt Lake, and Foster Village communities by  
appropriating funds to operate an additional emergency medical  
service unit.

The Honolulu Emergency Services Department, Emergency Medical  
Service Division, and an individual supported this measure. The  
Department of Health commented on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its  
effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion.

Should this measure be deliberated further in the legislative  
process, your Committee respectfully requests that the Committee  
on Finance consider specifying that the emergency medical service  
unit be used to support daily peak hours.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your  
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
