Your Committee on Health, to which was referred H.B. No. 1373
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO LEAHI HOSPITAL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish a working group
to develop a plan to transfer all parcels of land contained within
the Leahi Hospital campus to the Hawaii Health Systems
Corporation.

The Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, Hawaii Health Systems
Corporation - Oahu Region, and an individual supported this
measure. The University of Hawaii opposed this measure. The
Department of Health commented on this measure.

As this measure proceeds through the legislative process,
your Committee encourages further discussion and consideration of
the issues and concerns raised in the University of Hawaii's
written testimony, including issues related to long-range planning
for Kapiolani Community College.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its
effective date to July 1, 2050, to facilitate further discussion.


As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No.
