Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 141
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO QUALIFIED COMMUNITY
REHABILITATION PROGRAMS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify that the \$850,000
maximum limit for the civil service exemption for contracts for
building, custodial, and grounds maintenance services with
qualified community rehabilitation programs applies to the maximum
amount per contract.

Ka Lima O Maui and numerous individuals supported this
measure. The United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, AFL-CIO
opposed this measure.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 141
and recommends that it pass Third Reading.
