Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 1527 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TAXATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require the Department of Taxation to evaluate and make recommendations regarding the repeal of certain tax credits and tax exemptions and to report to the Legislature before the Regular Session of 2018. This measure also requires, beginning on July 1, 2018 and every five years thereafter, the Department to evaluate and make recommendations regarding new tax credits and exemptions.

The United Public Workers, AFSCME, Local 646, and AFL-CIO provided testimony in support of this measure. The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism; Kaua'i County Housing Agency; Land Use Research Foundation of Hawaii; Hawai'i Association of Realtors; and Mutual Housing Association of Hawai'i, Inc. provided testimony in opposition. The Department of Taxation and Tax Foundation of Hawaii provided commments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2030, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity, consistency, and style.
