Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 173
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE REPEAL OF FUNDS AND
ACCOUNTS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to repeal and transfer the
unencumbered balances of the following funds and accounts to the
credit of the general fund:

- (1) Aloha Tower Fund;
- (2) Transportation Use Special Fund;
- (3) Amtrak Trust Account;
- (4) Hurricane Iniki Insurance Proceeds Special Fund; and
- (5) Deposits-Plans and Specifications Trust Account.


The Department of Transportation and the Office of the

commented on this measure.



Your Committee has amended this measure by removing the repeal of the Aloha Tower Fund. Technical, nonsubstantive amendments were also made for clarity, consistency, and style.

No. 173, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 173, H.D. 1, and be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.
