Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred  
H.B. No. 1824 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO PRESERVATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the  
College of Tropical Agriculture and Human Resources of the  
University of Hawaii to restore and preserve its collection of  
historic relief maps of the Hawaiian Islands.

The University of Hawaii, Department of Botany of the  
University of Hawaii, and many concerned individuals supported  
this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the amount appropriated for the restoration and  
preservation of historic relief maps of the Hawaiian  
Islands to an unspecified amount; and
- (2) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2525, to  
encourage further discussion.


Should the Committee on Finance deliberate this measure  
further, your Committee on Higher Education respectfully requests  
that it consider appropriating \$250,000 for the purposes of



restoring and preserving historic relief maps of the Hawaiian Islands.
