Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred  
H.B. No. 1883 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII  
CENTER ON AGING,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds for a  
permanent full-time associate professor and permanent full-time  
assistant specialist position within the University of Hawaii  
Center on Aging.

The University of Hawai'i at Manoa Myron B. Thompson School of  
Social Work, The University of Hawai'i, AARP, the Alzheimer's  
Association-Aloha Chapter, Policy Advisory Board for Elder  
Affairs, ASN Consulting Services, the Hawai'i Family Caregiver  
Coalition, Hawaii Pacific Gerontological Society, Kokua Council,  
and numerous individuals testified in support of this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the appropriated amount for one full-time  
equivalent (1.0 FTE) associate professor position within  
the University of Hawaii Center on Aging from \$86,532 to  
an unspecified amount;
- (2) Changing the appropriated amount for one full-time  
equivalent (1.0 FTE) assistant specialist position




within the University of Hawaii Center on Aging from \$75,924 to an unspecified amount; and

- (3) Changing the effective date to July 1, 2525, to facilitate further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Higher Education that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1883, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1883, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Finance.
