Your Committees on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs and Water & Land, to which was referred H.B. No. 2035 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to establish a three-year pilot project to promote photovoltaic powered desalinization on the island of Ko'olawe and to study the benefits of the technology's use.

The Koho'olawe Island Reserve Commission and numerous individuals testified in support of this measure. The Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism offered comments on this measure. Two individuals testified in opposition to this measure.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the appropriation sum from \$500,000 to an unspecified amount; and
- (2) Changing the effective date to December 24, 2088.




appropriating \$500,000 for the establishing and implementing of a three-year photovoltaic powered desalinization pilot project.
