The Department of the Attorney General testified in opposition. The Council for Native Hawaiian Advancement and Sovereign Councils of the Hawaiian Homelands Assembly provided comments.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
