The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the
Kahoolawe Island Reserve Commission for projects to restore and
preserve the natural, cultural, and historic resources of the
Kahoolawe Island Reserve.

The Aha Moku Advisory Committee, County of Maui Department of
Planning, County of Maui Office of the Mayor, Kahoolawe Island
Reserve Commission, the Trust for Public Land, Conservation
Council for Hawaii, Historic Hawaii Foundation, Land Use Research
Foundation of Hawaii, Protect Kahoolawe Ohana, and many
individuals supported this measure. The Center for Hawaiian
Sovereignty Studies and an individual submitted testimony in
opposition of this measure. The Office of the Auditor provided
comments on this measure.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Water & Land and Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian
Affairs that are attached to this report, your Committees are in
accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 438 and recommend
that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on
Finance.


