Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 452
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO STATEWIDE SEXUAL ASSAULT
SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to appropriate funds to the
Department of the Attorney General for the current fiscal biennium
for statewide sexual assault services and to establish a minimum
base budget amount for future fiscal years.

The Crime Victim Compensation Commission, Sex Abuse Treatment
Center, Kokua Council & AARP 60, YWCA of Hawaii Island, YWCA of
Kauai, and Child & Family Service supported this measure. The
Department of the Attorney General commented on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Changing the amounts appropriated to the Department of
the Attorney General and the minimum base budget amount
to unspecified amounts; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for clarity,
consistency, and style.



As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Finance that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 452, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Third Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 452, H.D. 1.
