Your Committee on Higher Education, to which was referred
H.B. No. 52 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE SELECTIVE SERVICE
REGISTRATION AWARENESS AND COMPLIANCE ACT,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to require compliance with the
Military Selective Service Act to be eligible for enrollment in a
state-supported post-secondary institution, qualify for state
financial assistance for post-secondary education, or be eligible
for state or county employment or service.

The Selective Service System - Hawaii Headquarters supported
this measure. The University of Hawaii and Department of the
Attorney General submitted comments.


Your Committee has amended this measure by clarifying that
the issues addressed by the measure are a matter of statewide

Article X, section 6, of the Hawaii State Constitution.
