to which was referred H.C.R. No. 149 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING A SUNRISE ANALYSIS OF
MANDATORY INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED
DISEASE SCREENINGS,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Auditor to
conduct a sunrise analysis of mandatory insurance coverage for
sexually transmitted disease screenings, including screenings for
human immunodeficiency virus and acquired immunodeficiency
syndrome, during a female insured's annual pelvic exam, as set
forth under H.B. No. 1897 and S.B. No. 2323.

Kaiser Permanente supported this measure. The Department of
Commerce and Consumer Affairs commented on this measure.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your
Committees on Health and Consumer Protection & Commerce that are
attached to this report, your Committees concur with the intent
and purpose of H.C.R. No. 149 and recommend that it be referred to
your Committee on Finance.
