Your Committees on Water and Land and Public Safety,  
Intergovernmental and Military Affairs, to which was referred S.B.  
No. 1021 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to remove the  
public funds restriction and appropriates general funds for  
construction of the state law enforcement memorial.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Department of Public Safety and Honolulu Police  
Department.

Your Committees find that Act 14, Session Laws of Hawaii  
2011, requires that a state law enforcement memorial be  
constructed in the Capitol district. This memorial will honor law  
enforcement officers from city, county, state, military, and  
federal agencies who have died in the line of duty, while serving  
the people of Hawaii. The Hawaii Law Enforcement Memorial  
Foundation has raised \$500,000 toward construction of the memorial  
and has selected a design for the memorial. This measure will  
enable construction to commence.

As affirmed by the records of votes of the members of your  
Committees on Water and Land and Public Safety, Intergovernmental  
and Military Affairs that are attached to this report, your  
Committees are in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.



No. 1021 and recommend that it pass Second Reading and be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
