Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred
S.B. No. 1120 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO NOTICE OF HEARING BY THE LABOR
AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS APPEALS BOARD,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to allow the Labor
and Industrial Relations Appeals Board the option to provide
notice of a hearing by posting on its webpage when service by
first class mail has been unsuccessful.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations and the
Labor and Industrial Relations Appeals Board.


Your Committee finds that under existing law, if the Labor
and Industrial Relations Appeals Board is unable to effect service
of a hearing notice by first class mail, it may effect notice by
publication in a newspaper. The Labor and Industrial Relations
Appeals Board has testified that this measure would provide it
with an effective and cost-saving alternative to effecting notice
of a hearing.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report,
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.
No. 1120 and recommends that it pass Second Reading and be placed
on the calendar for Third Reading.
