Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred  
S.B. No. 133 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT  
SYSTEM,"

The purpose and intent of this measure is to allow the courts  
to decree a forfeiture of benefits by an Employees' Retirement  
System member, former member, or retirant upon a conviction of a  
felony and finding that the felony is related to the member,  
former member, or retirant's employment by the State or any  
county.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure  
from the Employees' Retirement System.

Your Committee has amended this measure by inserting an  
effective date of January 7, 2059, to encourage further  
discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your  
Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report,  
your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B.  
No. 133, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second  
Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 133, S.D. 1, and  
be referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.
