Your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and
Military Affairs, to which was referred S.B. No. 2825 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE PACIFIC INTERNATIONAL
SPACE CENTER FOR EXPLORATION SYSTEMS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to eliminate the ex
officio nonvoting National Aeronautics and Space Administration
representative from the Pacific International Space Center for
Exploration Systems Board of Directors.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and
Tourism.

Your Committee finds that the ex officio, nonvoting
representative of the National Aeronautics and Space
Administration (NASA) on the Board of Directors of the Pacific
International Space Center for Exploration Systems (PISCES) is
counted as a member of the board for purposes of achieving quorum.
Historically, the NASA representative has not participated in
PISCES board meetings, which often makes it difficult for the
board to establish a quorum to conduct business and adopt
decisions. For this reason, your Committee finds that the ex
officio, nonvoting NASA representative should be eliminated from
the board, reducing the number of board members from ten to nine.



Your Committee has amended this measure by making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Public Safety, Intergovernmental, and Military Affairs that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 2825, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 2825, S.D. 1, and be placed on the calendar for Third Reading.
