relating to health.


Prior to the hearing on this measure, your Committee posted
and made available for public review a proposed S.D. 1, which
amends this measure by deleting its contents and replacing it with
language to clarify that medical health professionals who are
employed by the State receive a qualified immunity from personal
liability when exercising their governmental discretion as
employees of the State while acting in the course and scope of
their state employment.

Your Committee has amended this measure by adopting the
proposed S.D. 1.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your
Committee on Health that is attached to this report, your
Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 50,
as amended herein, and recommends that it be recommitted to the
Committee on Health, in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 50,
