Your Committee on Ways and Means, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 146, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF
EDUCATION TO WORK WITH A SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE TO DEVELOP A
PROOF OF CONCEPT FOR THE PLANNING AND DESIGNING OF A
GYMNASIUM AT ANUENUE SCHOOL,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to request that the
Department of Education, a school of architecture, and Kula
Kaiapuni 'O Ānuenue enter a partnership to develop a proof of
concept plan and design for a gymnasium at Ānuenue School.

Your Committee received written comments in support of this
measure from the Department of Education.

Your Committee finds that students at Ānuenue School, a
Hawaiian immersion school for students in kindergarten through
twelfth grade, are very active in a variety of athletic events and
sports. However, the school lacks a gymnasium and the physical
constraints of the Ānuenue School site limit the available space
to expand. Thus, designing and constructing gymnasium facilities
at the school are a challenge.


Your Committee further finds that establishing a partnership
between the Department of Education, a school of architecture, and
Kula Kaiapuni 'O Ānuenue will allow the development of plans and



designs for gymnasium facilities, while providing valuable learning opportunities for architectural students.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Ways and Means that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 146, S.D. 1, and recommends its adoption.
