Your Committee on Judiciary and Labor, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 71 entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION DESIGNATING APRIL 28, 2016, AS
"WORKERS' MEMORIAL DAY" IN HAWAII IN MEMORY OF WORKERS
KILLED, INJURED, OR DISABLED IN THE WORKPLACE,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to designate
April 28, 2016, as "Workers' Memorial Day" in Hawaii in memory of
workers killed, injured, or disabled in the workplace.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations, Hawai'i
Construction Alliance, Hawaii State AFL-CIO, and two individuals.

Your Committee finds that every year in America, thousands of
workers are killed as a result of workplace injuries and
occupational illnesses. In 2014, thirty-one Hawaii workers fell
victim to fatal work injuries. Implementation of this measure
will honor and pay tribute to the courageous and dedicated members
of Hawaii's labor force who have been injured, disabled, or killed
as a result of workplace accidents.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting language to clarify that Workers' Memorial Day
is annually observed throughout the world on April 28
and that the date was selected because it is the



anniversary of the founding of the Occupational Safety and Health Administration; and

- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Judiciary and Labor that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of S.C.R. No. 71, as amended herein, and recommends its adoption in the form attached hereto as S.C.R. No. 71, S.D. 1.


